## LFT's

**Understanding Labs** – pay a lot of attention to labs. You should be able to interpret labs. Today we worked with a patient who had LFT's.

- <u>LFT's</u> detect damage; not function
  - o AST (a stupid test): found in many parts of the body (hepatocyte, muscle, heart) thus not specific. Ratio of AST: ALT may help identify cirrhosis.
  - o ALT (a liver test): specific to hepatocyte
  - o GGT specific to biliary system
  - o Alk phos: biliary or bone
  - o Bilirubin: biliary system
    - Indirect = unconjugated
    - Direct = conjugated
- Functional tests
  - o PT/PTT
  - o TP/albumin/pre-albumin
  - o Vitamin D hydoxylated in liver
  - o NH<sub>4</sub> elevated in liver failure
